Rev. George Davis-Williams lives in Lake City, Michigan with his husband, Leif—a high school chemistry teacher—and their 5th-grade son, Matthew. Together, they are a family on the move, enjoying camping, hunting, raising chickens, mountain biking, and making maple syrup. If they're not at home, chances are they're out in the woods with their Australian Shepherd, Simon.

George earned his Master of Divinity from United Theological Seminary of the Twin Cities and was ordained in May 2025 into the United Church of Christ. He currently serves part-time as the Outreach Minister at First Congregational Church (UCC) in Cadillac, Michigan, while working full-time as a school nurse for the local health department.

His educational background also includes a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Saginaw Valley State University (2009) and an Associate of Applied Science in Mortuary Science from Amarillo College (2010). After over a decade working in both nursing and funeral services, George felt called to seminary. His goal: to support small congregations that may not be able to afford a full-time pastor by embracing bi-vocational ministry.

"Unless someone like you cares a whole awful lot, nothing is going to get better. It's not." With Christ by our side, let's work together toward a better world.
