Rev. Dr. Sid Hall, III, is a writer, activist, and a pastor. He has preached several times at 1st Congregational Church of Charlevoix and is happy to be back again. A native of northern Indiana, Sid grew up in the summers with Pastor Toby in Bay View. Each year Sid serves as the spring kahu (pastor) at Wānanalua Congregational Church (UCC) in Hāna, Island of Maui, Hawai'i. He is an active member of the 'Aha O Nā Mokupuni 'O Maui, Moloka'i a Me Lāna'I Association in the Hawai'i Conference of the UCC.

Sid retired in 2021 from full time ministry after 42 years as a United Methodist and United Church of Christ minister in Indiana and Texas. For 33 years, Sid was the lead minister of Trinity Church of Austin, a progressive congregation in Austin, Texas affiliated with the United Church of Christ, the United Methodist Church, and Creation Spirituality Communities. Sid is married to Mary Pratt, a retired psychotherapist and adjunct professor. They reside in Windsor, Colorado, Hāna, Hawai'i, and on Crooked Lake in Conway, Michigan. Mary and Sid have four adult children and three grandchildren.
